

2014 Striped Bass Transfer Options: Single Permits and Pounds

ITQ Fishery

If you declare to fish your allocation in the ITQ fishery, you will have the pre-season and in-season transfer options described below.

Pre-Season Transfer Options (August 1 – September 30)

- Option A: (No Transfer) Renew your permit and catch your poundage in 2014.
- Option B: Transfer your permit *and/or* allocation to a non-permitted tidal fish licensee. Note that you cannot hold pounds without a permit.
- Option C: Transfer all (or a portion of) your allocation to another permit holder. You are limited to four transfers during the pre-season transfer period.

In-Season Transfer Options (January 1 – December 31) (not finalized)

- Option A: (No Transfer) Fish your permit and allocation in 2014.
- Option B: Transfer your permit *and* allocation to a non-permitted tidal fish licensee.
- Option C: Transfer any remaining poundage on your permit to another permit holder.

Common Pool Fishery

If you declare to fish your permit in the Common Pool Fishery, you will have August and March to transfer your permit. See details below.

Pre-Season Transfer Options (August)

- Option A: (No Transfer) Keep your permit and fish in the Common Pool Fishery.
- Option B: Transfer your permit to another non-permitted tidal fish licensee to fish in the Common Pool.

In-Season Transfer Options (March)

- Option A: (No Transfer) Keep your permit and fish in the Common Pool Fishery.
- Option B: Transfer your permit to another non-permitted tidal fish licensee to fish in the Common Pool.
