The Maryland DNR Forest Service Fire Management Staff is offering the NWCG certified training courses S-130 – Wildland Firefighter; S-190 – Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior and L-180 – Human Factors on the Fireline. These are the basic wildland fire courses and are also prerequisites for an entry level wildland firefighter.

There is no cost for tuition or course materials. Meals and lodging are not provided.

Note: Minimum class size is 10 students. Maximum class size is 35 students.

Maryland Wildland Fire Crew: candidates must complete the above courses; two additional online courses IS-700.a & IS-100.b (see below); and pass a physical endurance test called the Work Capacity (Pack) test. The announcement for Pack Test dates and registration will be posted in February 2017. Red cards may be issued after successful completion of all requirements.

Additional Online Training: Required for agency certification as a Maryland Wildland Firefighter I or to be Red Carded as a FFT2.
