GOOSE HUNTING CLINIC & HUNT ON MARYLAND'S EASTERN SHORE— JAN. 10-11, 2016

Join the experienced staff of the Maryland Department of Natural Resources and Blue Stem Farms for 2 days you will never forget! If you have ever wanted to experience Maryland's Eastern Shore goose hunting but were not sure how to get started, then this is the clinic for you. Sunday, Jan. 10th will be spent at the beautiful Schrader's Bridgetown Manor located in Caroline County. Classroom instruction will cover the hows and whys of waterfowl hunting, including safety, state and federal laws and regulations, as well as hunting skills and techniques. You also will enjoy shooting trap, a tour of the Bridgetown Manor and watching a retriever dog demonstration. On Monday Jan. 11th, we will travel to Blue Stem Farms, located in Queen Anne's County to participate in a real Eastern Shore guided goose hunt. Hopefully, you will go home with a goose or, at the very least, some wonderful memories. Register NOW! Only 15 reservations are available. **This workshop is open to women who are new to or have little experience goose hunting. Priority will be given to new participants***. Participants may bring a non-hunting spouse or partner. However, they are required to register at full price and will not be permitted to carry a firearm. Deadline for registration (mailed in only) is December 18, 2015.

** Priority will be given to new or novice goose hunters who have not participated in this workshop. Previous and experienced participants are encouraged to register however we will hold your registration forms until December 7th when you will be notified if you have successfully registered.*

Fee: \$195 – includes lodging, instruction, meals, round of sporting clays & shotgun shells.

Valid Maryland Hunting License required including a Maryland Migratory Bird Stamp and a Federal Migratory Bird Stamp.
