


# Billingsley CWMA



## Rules and Regulations for Billingsley CWMA

1. A permit and daily reservation is required. Contact Myrtle Grove WMA for information (301) 743-5161
  2. Open for Archery Deer Hunting Only. (Maximum of 6 hunters per day) Hunting is permitted in the wooded areas of zones 1 and 3 only.
  3. Your first Deer Must be antlerless.
  4. Hunting will be permitted Monday through Friday from 1:00 PM until ½ hour after sunset.
  5. Hunters must sign in upon entering the property and indicate their hunting spot using the map and sign in sheet.
  6. When leaving, hunters must remove the pin indicating where they were, and sign out. Deer harvested must also be recorded when signing out.
  7. Parking is allowed in designated spots only.
  8. Driving in fields or on undesignated roads is prohibited.
  9. You must call the Park Rangers (301-627-7755) if a deer needs to be tracked outside of the hunting area or later than legal hunting hours.
  10. Deer harvested at Billingsley will count against your Region B bag limit.
- When you check your deer, be sure to indicate it was harvested on public land.  
The county code is 16 (PG) and the public land code is 488.

Entrance and exit for Billingsley is at the end of Maude Savoy Brown Road off of US 301. There is a gate across the road at the entrance to the WSSC Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Directions to gain entry:

- At the gate there is a small gray box with a call button.
- Press the button and wait for someone to respond.
- After they respond, state your name and tell them you are going to the Billingsley property.
- After the gate opens, proceed straight.
- Turn left on Burgdorf Blvd. And continue to follow the signs that read "Billingsley House Museum".
- Shortly after you cross a small bridge, the sign in sheet and map will be on your right.

To exit:

- Sign out, record any deer harvested and remove your marker.
- Follow the signs that read "Exit to Rt. 301".
- When you reach the gate, stop where the sign tells you.
- The gate will open automatically and you may exit.
